INSTRUCTIONS FOR SKIN CARE AFTER BIOPSY

*Wash your hands thoroughly with soap and water.

*Clean the wound daily with soap and water while in shower then pat dry.

*Apply a thin layer of BACITRACIN or VASELINE to the wound.

(DO NOT USE NEOSPORIN OR TRIPLE ANTIBIOTIC)

*Apply a dressing (i.e., Band-aid)

*Continue all instructions above until the wound is healed or is no longer scabbing or crusting over.

*The wound will get mildly red and raised around the edges and white to yellow in the center. This is likely normal.

*If bleeding occurs, apply direct pressure with a towel for 15-20 minutes without looking at the wound.

| *Foul odor | *Extreme itching |

| *Increased or abnormal drainage | *Bumps around site |
| *Increase in pain | *Redness that is spreading |
